**ORDINANCE #2015:04**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #4-67 REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF**  
**MINORS ON PUBLIC STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES BETWEEN CERTAIN**  
**HOURS AT NIGHT WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HI-NELLA**  
**SECTION 1 AND SECTION 3**

BE IT ORDAINED by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hi-Nella. County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Ordinance #4-67 is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of seventeen years to be upon the streets, alleys, roads, parks, gazebo or other public places, or any place of amusement or recreation after the hour of 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM the following morning, unless accompanied by the parent or guardian or other adult person having the care, custody or control of said child.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
